Introduction



Drake Music is an organisation that works across the UK with disabled people who use new ways to make music.



We are offering **bursaries** to 3 new **musicians**.

A **bursary** is money given to someone to help them with something.



A **musician** is any artist who makes music or sound in their own way.



This information will tell you all about our bursaries and how to apply for one.

What our bursaries offer

Our bursaries offer:



- £750 to spend on your work.



- access to our music opportunities and classes.



- sharing your work with organisations we work with.



You can spend the money you get from the bursary in any way that helps your work.

This could include things like:



- new technology you might need.



- working with other musicians.



- music equipment.



- classes and training.

What we would like from you



You do not need to make a piece of work or performance using the bursary.



Instead, we would like to find out what our bursary has supported you to do.

You could tell us how the bursary has helped you in any way you want, like:



- writing or drawing.



- photos or video.



- voice recording.

Who can apply?



You can apply for our bursary if you are:



- a new musician - this means you have less experience as a musician and have not had a bursary before.



- disabled or have a long term illness.




- Asian, Black or from an Ethnic Minority background.



You must be all 3 of these to get our bursary.

We will think very carefully about who gets our bursary.

How to apply



To apply for our bursary you need to send an application to:

Your application should have these sections:



- Section 1:

A bit about yourself and your music.



- Section 2:

Why you want or need the bursary.



- Section 3:

What you will spend the bursary money on.

Please also send:



- 1 example of your work - this could be something like a song you wrote or a video of a performance you did.



- links to your **social media** if you have any.

Social media is websites like Twitter, Facebook and Instagram.

You can do your application:



- in writing - please don't write more than 500 words for each section.



- by video recording - please don't send a video of longer than 3 minutes for each section.



- by voice recording - please don't send a voice recording of longer than 3 minutes for each section.



Please send your application by midnight on 21 February 2022.




In March we will have chosen who gets our 3 bursaries and they will be given out.
