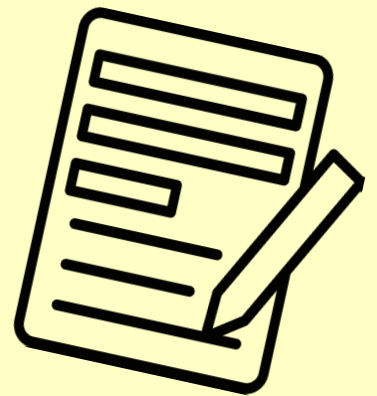

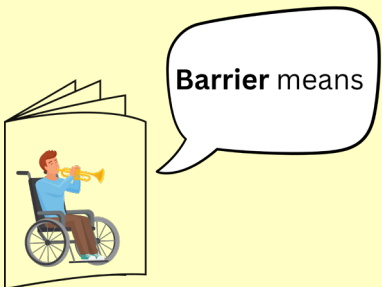
About this form

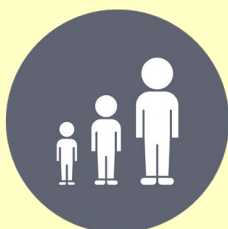

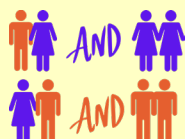

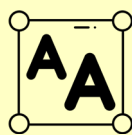
