10 questions in total

- About you: 4 short questions
- About your music: 1 track & short question
- Application questions: 4 longer questions
- Declaration: 1 question

About you

1. Name
2. Email
3. Phone number
4. Do you see yourself as part of the Global Majority?

About your music: track

5. Share a track that shows us what kind of music you make.

- Doesn't have to be professionally recorded
- Can be on phone or laptop
- Must be original
- Can be made up of short parts from different tracks
- Should be under 5 minutes
- Tell us what role you played in creating the track

Longer questions

- 200 words or 2 minutes
- It's ok if it's a bit longer or shorter
- Your opportunity to tell us about yourself
- Remember that the panel will **only** know what you put in your application
- You can answer in bullet points or full sentences
